Investment Objective

AmASEAN Equity (the "Fund") seeks to provide capital growth over the medium to long-term by investing in Shariah-compliant equities and Shariah-compliant equity-related securities with exposure to the ASEAN markets.

The Fund is suitable for investors:

- seeking to participate in an investment of the fast growing ASEAN economies; and
- willing to take higher risks in anticipation of potentially higher returns over the medium to long-term*.

Notes: *Medium to long-term refers to a period of at least three (3) years.

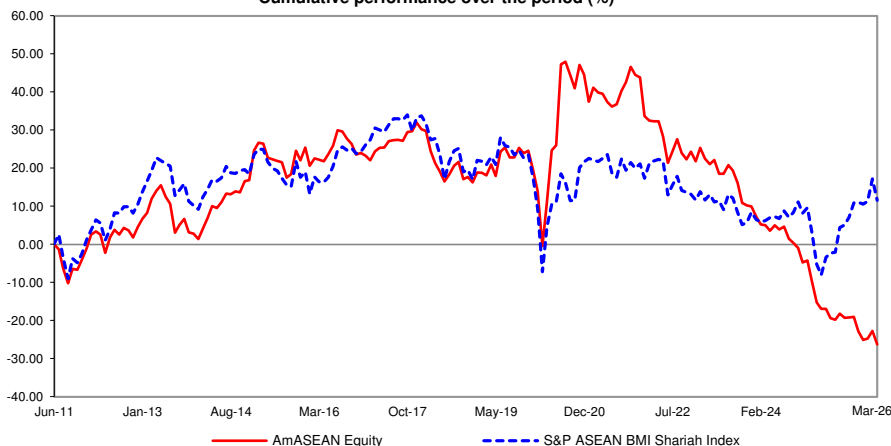

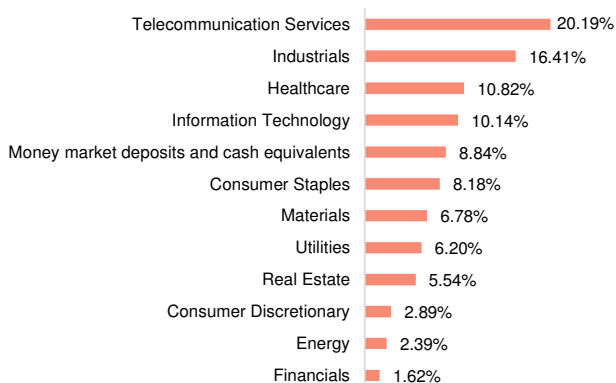

Sector Allocation (as at 31 March 2026)



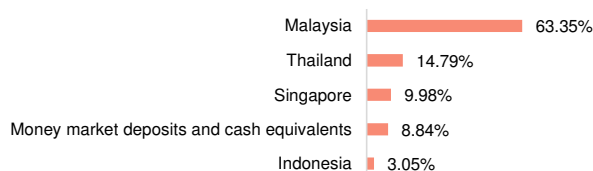

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Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 31 March 2026, the Volatility Factor ("VF") for this Fund is 7.6 and is classified as "Low" (Source: Lipper). "Low" Includes funds with VF that are higher than 4.370 and lower than 8.135 (Source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class ("VC") is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.

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
