Investment Objective


AmIslamic Growth (the "Fund") aims to provide long-term*** capital growth mainly through investments in securities with superior growth potential*, which conforms to principles of Shariah.

The Fund is suitable for investors seeking:

- seeking diversified portfolio of Islamic equities with emphasis on growth;
- seeking potential capital growth from Islamic investments rather than regular income** distribution; and
- with long-term*** investment goal.





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Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 31 March 2025, the Volatility Factor ("VF") for this Fund is 10.1 and is classified as "Moderate" (Source: Lipper). "Moderate" Includes funds with VF that are higher than 9.215 and lower than 12.075 (Source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class ("VC") is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.

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
