Investment Objective

Asia-Pacific Property Equities (the "Fund") seeks to provide income, with a dividend yield higher than the benchmark, plus the potential for capital growth over the long term.

The Fund is suitable for investors:

- seeking potential long-term* capital appreciation through Asia-Pacific markets; and
- seeking potential income** and capital growth through exposure to Asia-Pacific property related securities.

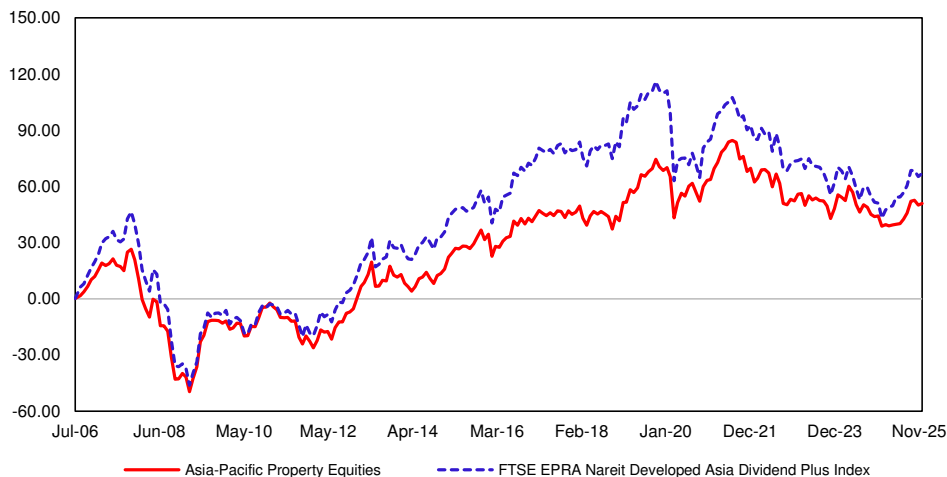
Note: *Long-term refers to a period of at least five (5) years.

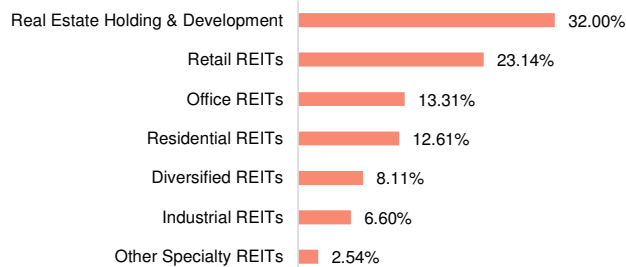

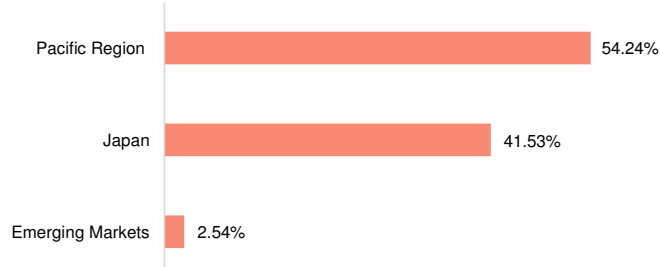

Target Fund Manager's Commentary (as at 30 November 2025)

Asian property equities had a positive month and outperformed the wider equity market, which declined due to a slump in technology stocks and renewed anxiety about the Chinese property sector. Japan (up 5.1%) outperformed, led by developers reporting strong results, some of which came in ahead of expectations and saw firms raising guidance (forecasts) and announcing new buyback programs. Hong Kong (up 2.6%) also had a positive month as luxury retail landlords and residential developers continued to be buoyed by recovering fundamentals. Meanwhile, retail landlords more focused on staples and necessities had a weaker period as spending in this area showed signs of weakening. Singapore (up 0.9%) was flat over the month with small- and mid-cap names leading due to the ongoing boost from the government's new equity development programme. Australia lagged (up 0.1%), weighed down by the underperformance of residential-focused names which were impacted by dampened expectations of further rate cuts.

Stock selection in Australia detracted from performance. This was slightly offset by positive contribution from stock selection in Japan and Singapore. At the stock level, the Australian holdings in industrial property landlord Goodman Group and property developer Stockland detracted from returns. Conversely, the position in Japan's Tokyo Tatemono contributed positively, as did the holdings in Wharf Real Estate Investment Company and Centurion Accommodation REIT. In terms of activity, we closed the position in HMC Capital. We believe there may be execution risk in some of the initiatives it has planned and the potential for it to miss its earnings guidance.

Amid heightened uncertainty pertaining to tariffs and other policies emanating from the Trump administration, we believe the defensive characteristics of real estate – namely predictable cash flows from contractual leases – have become more attractive relative to other sectors in a slower growth environment. The interest-rate backdrop has also become more supportive, with many central banks now turning to monetary policy easing and benchmark rates across the region have started to decline.

Fundamentals remain healthy across most property subsectors, and we expect real estate, which are predominantly domestic-oriented businesses, to show relative resilience versus the broader equities market as volatility increases. The declining supply has become more supportive, and we expect ultimately strong pricing power across the sector once the macroeconomic backdrop stabilizes.

We think the long-term benefits of owning listed real estate remain, as the asset class has historically offered lower correlations to many other asset classes and provided investors with the benefits of portfolio enhancement by increasing risk-adjusted returns within a balanced portfolio. The real estate market continues to provide an attractive, reliable and growing income stream for investors, which is something we expect to be rewarded over time.

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Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 30 November 2025, the Volatility Factor ("VF") for this Fund is 8.6 and is classified as "Moderate" (Source: Lipper). "Moderate" includes funds with VF that are higher than 7.805 and lower than 10.405 (Source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class ("VC") is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
