Investment Objective

AmRobotech Fund (formerly known as Robotech Fund) (the "Fund") aims to provide long-term* capital growth by investing in the Target Fund which invests in an actively managed listed equity and equity-related securities portfolio.

The Fund is suitable for sophisticated investors seeking for:

- capital appreciation over a long term* investment horizon; and
- portfolio diversification through exposure in global equity market.

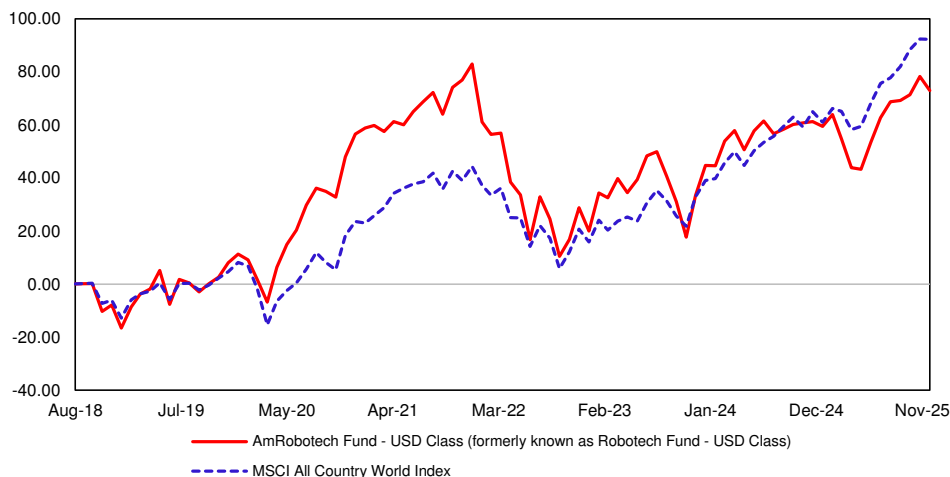
Note: *Long term refers to a period at least five (5) years.

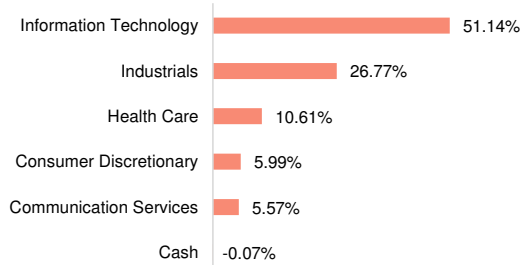

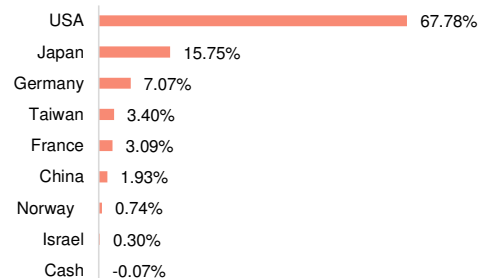
Target Fund's Sector Allocation* (as at 30 November 2025)

Target Fund Manager's Commentary (as at 30 November 2025)

The Robotech strategy fell during the month (in USD terms) and underperformed the MSCI All Country World Index during the period. Our healthcare holdings performed well during the month. The standout was Globus Medical (Spinal Robotic Surgery) whose share price increased more than 50% during the month following results that significantly beat investor expectations. Globus has been navigating a period of uncertainty over the last few quarters following the acquisition of Nevro (a pain management company), which had the potential to be a more complicated integration. Elsewhere in healthcare, Dexcom and Intuitive Surgical were positive contributors to performance. Alphabet performed well after the launch of its latest AI model, Gemini 3. Initial benchmarking data suggested that Gemini 3 was on par with Open AI's latest model. Gemini 3 represents the first time that Google had trained a frontier model entirely on its own silicon – this news lifted the share prices of Broadcom (Google's design partner for TPUs) and weighted on the share price of GPU makers Nvidia and AMD. Our holding in Keyence was weak during the month. Whilst we have generally seen an improvement in orders in Japanese automation companies, Keyence has lagged peers as we saw weaker than expected operating margins and are not yet seeing clear signs of a recovery at Keyence. During the month, we trimmed our position in NXP Semiconductor and increased our position in Infineon. Both companies are leaders in analog semiconductors, with strength in their automotive portfolios – However we see Infineon continue grow their power solutions for Data Centers which enhances the company's growth during a period where auto volumes continue to be soft. Within our warehouse automation holdings, we reduced our position in Zebra and increased our position in Cognex. Cognex's shares had been weak in recent weeks after reporting a good set of results, but talking down expectations for 2026. We are more constructive, seeing resilient customer spending in Cognex's key end markets of logistics and consumer electronics into 2026 and believe that the automotive end market is seeing signs of stabilization after a more difficult period. Elsewhere in the portfolio, we trimmed our position in Meta Platforms and added to Procept Biorobotics (robotic surgery) and AXON Enterprise (Public Safety Technologies) following share price weakness.

Investor sentiment has continued to improve as trade negotiations have progress and uncertainty has reduced. The current earnings season has generally been strong and we have seen a reassuring resilience of company results and an optimism that greater stability in global trade will allow companies to make investment decisions with greater clarity. The tariffs are seen by the US administration as a key tool to address what they deem to be unfair trade practises for many nations around the world and making foreign imports more expensive will be a key driver to support US manufacturing and reshore activity and jobs domestically. Ultimately, Trump's manufacturing agenda, if successful, should favour major investments in the US and we believe the Robotech strategy is well positioned to benefit from this. We also believe that Trump's push for deregulation and the emphasis on speeding up permitting process for construction should aid activity here.

We have seen very strong levels of CAPEX from the large Technology companies as they invest heavily in the infrastructure required for artificial intelligence and have seen indications that this heavily spending will continue in to 2026. This has been further supported by the passing of the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" in the US which allows for the immediate depreciation of infrastructure and R&D investments and is expected to provide significant tax savings for companies investing heavily. In Europe, we have seen initiatives principally from Germany, who have launched a 500 billion Euro Infrastructure and Climate Bill set up to support investment in Germany over the next 12 years as well as an initiative from 61 Corporates in Germany to invest 631bn Euros domestically by 2028.
