Investment Objective

US-Canada Income and Growth (the "Fund") seeks to provide regular income* and to a lesser extent long term** capital appreciation by investing in the Target Fund, which will be investing in equities securities, debt securities and convertible securities.

The Fund is suitable for Sophisticated Investors¹ seeking:

- regular income* and to a lesser extent long term** capital appreciation on their investments; and
- an investment portfolio of equities securities, debt securities and convertible securities via the Target Fund.

Note: *Income distribution (if any) is paid out on quarterly basis.

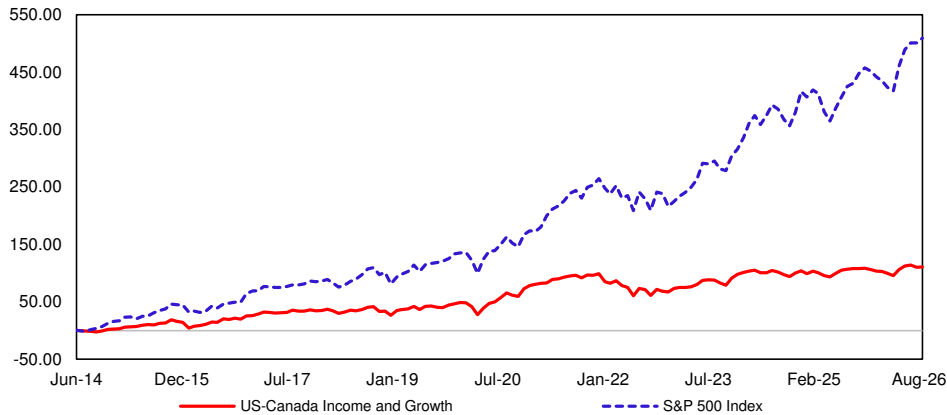
**Long term means the investment horizon should at least be five (5) years.

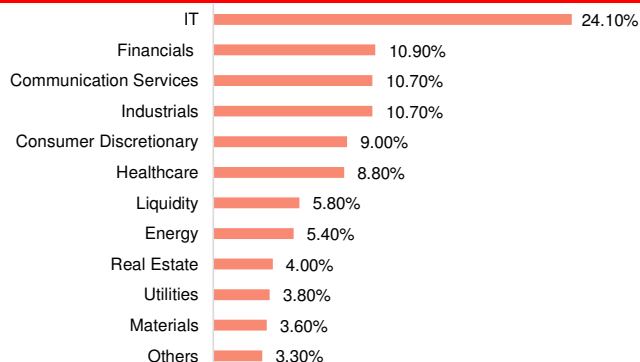

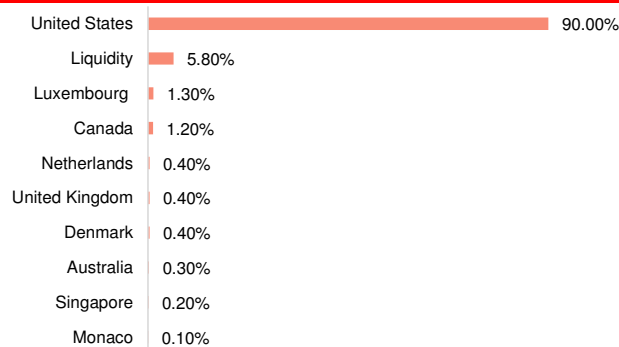
Target Fund's Sector Allocation* (as at 31 August 2026)

Target Fund Manager's Commentary (as at 31 August 2026)

The economic outlook is positive for H2, supported by the AI buildout and downstream effects of pro-growth domestic policies, as well as easier lending standards, sustained labour market stability and the potential for easing geopolitical tensions. Conversely, persistent inflation and/or a sharp increase in interest rates would be key economic risks.

The earnings outlook is also positive. Bottom-up estimates continue to trend higher, driven by better-than-expected results, earnings breadth expansion, robust AI spend, broadening investment, productivity gains, and durable margins. On the other hand, rising expenses and input costs are profitability headwinds.

Convertible securities' outperformance of equities could expand over the remainder of the year, and high yield bonds are pacing for a positive but below-coupon annual return. Given their defensive characteristics, these asset classes can mitigate market volatility better than equities, which historically average a mid-teens intra-year decline even in annual periods of positive returns.

US convertible securities have an attractive asymmetric return profile, providing upside participation potential when stock prices rise and downside mitigation when stock prices fall. The asset class is on pace to outperform the broad equity market again in 2026, helped by solid earnings growth, expanding market breadth, stable credit spreads, and robust new issuance. After record new issuance in 2025, primary market activity is trending for another unprecedented year with 2026 estimates residing around USD 130-135 billion.# Aside from diversification benefits, new issuance expands the opportunity set of investments with attractive terms and the desired risk/reward characteristics.

The US high yield market, yielding more than 7%^^, offers equity-like returns but with less volatility. The asset class is expected to deliver a positive, but below-coupon return for 2026. The market's attractive total return potential is a function of its discount to face value and higher coupon, which also serves to cushion downside volatility. Credit fundamentals are stable, near-term refinancing obligations remain low, and the market's credit quality composition has improved. In this environment, new issuance is expected to remain steady, spreads can stay tight, and the default rate should continue to reside below the historical average.

A covered call options strategy can be utilised to generate premium income. In periods of elevated or rising equity volatility, premiums collected may translate into more attractive annualised yields. Collectively, these three asset classes can provide a steady source of income and a compelling "participate and protect" return profile.
